

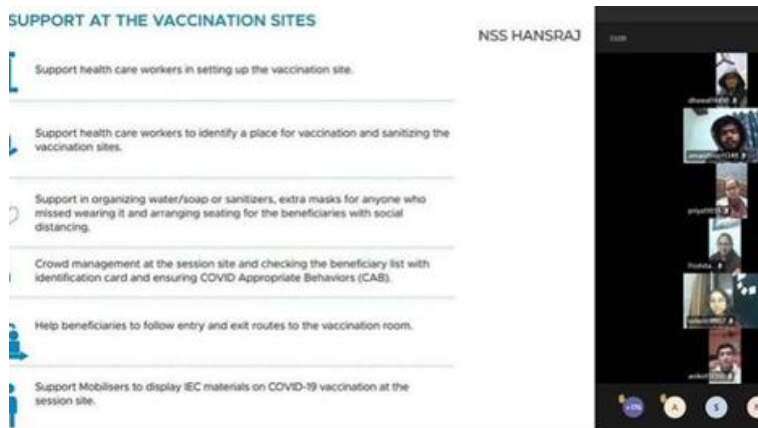

The mainstream medical establishment speaks with one voice: "Vaccines are a public health miracle far too valuable to put at risk".

It's been a year since the first case of SARS-Cov-2 was first reported in India. Amidst the stillness which prevailed since a long time, our country is finally ready to fight back through the first phase of mass inoculation programme. Owing to the same, NSS Hansraj organized a webinar on the topic "Awareness Regarding Covid Vaccine Rollout" on 13 January, 2021. Important information regarding Covid-19 vaccine, measures to curb vaccine hesitancy and CAB (Covid Appropriate Behaviour) which includes wearing mask, usage of sanitizers and practice of physical distancing were communicated to people by our volunteers.

The webinar, which was attended by 100+ participants, also had an FAQs session. In light of the questions posed about the availability, doses, side effects of the Indian-manufactured vaccines: Covaxin and Covishield, one's role as a responsible citizen during this rollout was also conveyed. Along with that, various other queries regarding the interval of dosage, eligibility, documents required, effectiveness and safety were solved.

At the end of the webinar, the Programme Officer of NSS Hansraj, Dr. Monika Koul addressed the volunteers and encouraged them to follow all the protocols and help in spreading genuine information and giving assistance to the needy during the vaccination rollout. It was a highly informative session which enlightened the attendees about Covid vaccination, and thus ended successfully.
