



Mr. Hemant, co-founder of many successful start-ups, highlighted the importance of funding for start-ups and provided valuable insights on funding opportunities. Both Ms. Ishita and Mr. Hemant emphasized the significance of having faith in one's team and the power of a good idea. Mr. Hemant discussed the importance of sticking to one's idea and Ms. Ishita talked about the importance of resilience in the face of challenges. The importance of learning from new experiences, the strength to stand up again after a debacle were important take away points for youngsters. The Indian ecosystem is ready for a change and young students need to take risks, the power of people, perseverance and passion were also few points that were discussed.




Overall, the panel discussion was a huge success, providing students with valuable insights and inspiration to pursue their entrepreneurial dreams.
